

In furtherance of our Data Protection Policy's objective, among others, we seek to achieve the following:

- To take bold steps to protect the confidentiality of our client's data, this includes ensuring that data is stored securely and that only authorized personnel have access to it.
- Collect the client's data that is necessary, process it in a lawful and transparent manner, ensure that it is accurate and up to date.
- Store client's data securely and must not retain the data for longer than is necessary.
- Protect the privacy of our employees' data and information.
- Protect personal data when visiting our website and when contacting us through email, phone and letter
- Process of personal data in connection with social network use
- Transfer of data to countries outside Nigeria
- Reference for user rights
- Notify the Nigeria Data Protection Bureau (NDPB) for any breaches in client's data.
- Process client data for specific and legitimate purposes.
